

Horse Racing Policy: EIPH Program Eligibility for Out of Jurisdiction Horses (Thoroughbred and Standardbred)

All policies regarding this matter dated prior to the date on this document are void.

A horse from a jurisdiction other than British Columbia, which has raced in that jurisdiction on furosemide in its last pari-mutuel start, may race in British Columbia on furosemide and will be considered to be a certified horse upon completion of the Racing Division Forms "B" and "D" by the Owner/Trainer/Authorized Agent.
