INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

The Gaming Policy and Enforcement Branch (GPEB) is required to conduct background checks for the purpose of registering Gaming Service Providers. As the landlord for an existing or proposed Gaming site, you meet the definition of Gaming Service Provider under the Gaming Control Act of British Columbia.

Because you are a landlord and have no other association or function with the Gaming Service, you will be required to provide written consent to allow a background check to be conducted. GPEB is required to protect the confidentiality and privacy of personal information provided in accordance with The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (British Columbia).

Registration is valid for a term of up to five years, providing the applicant continues to have an interest in the gaming facility and remains in good standing with the GPEB. Registration is not assignable or transferable.
