NOTES:

- Please refer to the *Gaming Control Act* (BC) and the Gaming Control Regulation for more information.
- Corporate applicants must submit a corporate disclosure package and all relevant employee packages.
- GPEB's review of the applicant may lead to the identification of other associated entities or persons that are required to provide disclosure and submit to a background investigation. Additional funds may be required to cover the costs of the background investigation.

1 The Application Fee is required to initiate a new or renewal application. The Annual Registration Fee is a yearly fee required to maintain registration. It is remitted to GPEB each year on or before the anniversary date (the date registration was approved by GPEB) for the term of the registration. The Application Fee and the Annual Registration Fee is the same. Annual fees do not apply to Gaming Workers, Horse Racing Workers or Associates.

2 A **Community Gaming Centre** is a gaming facility offering bingo and slots.

3 A **Class A bingo hall** is a gaming facility that generates gross sales of \$1 million or more annually from the operation of bingo, based on financial statements for the last fiscal year end.

4 A **Class B bingo hall** is a gaming facility that generate gross revenue of less that \$1 million annually from the operation of bingo, based on financial statements for the last fiscal year end.

5 **Senior Officials** are comprised of each of the 5 highest paid officers and each individual who, whether or not among those 5 highest paid officers, serves on the board of directors as chair, vice chair, president, vice president, secretary, treasurer or general manager of a gaming services provider, or performs functions similar to those normally performed by an individual occupying any of the aforementioned offices. Gaming Control Regulation, Section 29 (2) (a).

Note:

- Owners / Operators of *ancillary services providers* (building maintenance, equipment maintenance, janitorial, retail, and concession sales of food or other products or services) as prescribed in Section 3 (a) of the Gaming Control Regulation shall complete the Gaming Worker Disclosure Package 3, unless otherwise advised.
- Owners / Operators of security services, automated banking services, and training services as prescribed in Section 3 (b) (c) and (d) of the Gaming Control Regulation shall complete the Persons Disclosure Package 2A, unless otherwise advised.

6 **Senior Employees** are comprised of each individual who is a gaming control manager, security services provider at a gaming facility or program manager reporting directly to an individual in the senior official class above, or performs functions similar to those normally performed by an individual occupying any of the aforementioned positions. Gaming Control Regulation, Section 29 (2) (b).

This includes persons in key managerial positions with gaming services providers. Individuals serving as bingo manager, casino manager, security or surveillance manager, personnel manager, outside director, signing officer, or any person employed in a similar capacity may be required to submit the Personal Disclosure Form 2A. As companies may be structured differently, GPEB's review of the applicant may lead to the identification of other senior employees that are required to provide an application. GPEB may require an applicant to submit additional information considered necessary to ensure the conduct of a full and complete background investigation.

7 **Gaming Workers include:**

- personnel at a gaming facility: any person who directly delivers services (e.g., bingo caller, cashier, pit boss, food and beverage workers in a gaming facility, pari-mutuel ticket sellers, horse racing trades, technicians, security and surveillance staff) and excludes unpaid volunteer floor workers
- personnel of a licensee having managerial or financial responsibility for the operation or conduct of a Class A gaming event licence for which the projected gross revenue exceeds \$250,000
- personnel of a gaming services provider providing gaming services for a licenced gaming event such as a ticket raffle, bingo or social occasion casino, or for licenced gaming events at a fair or exhibition
- personnel of gaming services providers not normally employed at a gaming facility, but who require access to the facility to work
- minors who require registration
